Power, audio and control are delivered to the speaker via a CAT5 or CAT6 cable. Connection on the other end is made to the STNet™ Switch, which provides 40 watts PoE (Power over Ethernet) to each speaker. Configuration of the speaker is done via software. Should any problems occur with the speaker during operation, it will be reported immediately via SoundTube® monitoring software.

The loudspeaker shall consist of a 203.2 mm (8 in) low-frequency transducer and a 25.0 mm (1.00 in) high-frequency transducer with a frequency-dividing network installed in a vented enclosure. The lowfrequency voice coil diameter shall be 25.4 mm (1.00 in). The high-frequency transducer shall be constructed of silk material with a proprietary BroadBeam Ring® waveguide. Performance specifications of a typical production unit shall be as follows: Usable frequency response shall extend from 38 Hz − 20 kHz (-10 dB, half space, independently verified). The frequency-dividing network shall have a crossover frequency of 3.5 kHz.
