

3 Overview

The **VM-2HD** *HD/SD* - *SDI DA* is a high performance 1:2 distributor for all SDI video signals.

In particular, the VM-2HD:

- Supports up to 200m
- Accepts one input and distributes the signal to two identical outputs using BNC connectors
- Has a video bandwidth of 1.485GHz that enables it to be used for standard definition and high definition serial digital video signals (SD/HD-SDI)
- Also passes digital information (embedded audio, Teletext, time code and so on) during the vertical interval period
- Is SMPTE 292M, 259M and 344M compliant and supports data rates of 143, 177, 270, 360, 540, 1483.5, 1485Mbps
- Provides automatic, multi-rate, equalization and reclocking for losses typical with long runs of 75Ω co-axial cable **up to 200m**
- Has LEDs indicating the SDI resolution

To achieve the best performance:

- Connect only good quality connection cables, thus avoiding interference, deterioration in signal quality due to poor matching, and elevated noise levels (often associated with low quality cables)
- Avoid interference from neighboring electrical appliances and position your **VM-2HD** away from moisture, excessive sunlight and dust



Caution – No operator-serviceable parts inside unit.

Warning – Use only the Kramer Electronics input power wall adapter that is provided with this unit¹.

Warning – Disconnect power and unplug unit from wall before installing or removing device or servicing unit.

4 Your VM-2HD HD/SD - SDI DA




Figure 1: VM-2HD HD²/SD³ - SDI DA

Figure 1 and Table 1 define the VM-2HD HD/SD - SDI DA:

Table 1: VM-2HD HD/SD - SDI DA Features

| # | Feature | Function |
|---|----------------------------|---|
| 1 | OUT 1 BNC connector | Connects to the SDI acceptor 1 |
| 2 | OUT 2 BNC connector | Connects to the SDI acceptor 2 |
| 3 | 12V DC | +12V DC connector for powering the unit |
| 4 | <i>HD</i> ² LED | Lights when the SDI signal is HD ² |
| 5 | <i>SD</i> ³ LED | Lights when the SDI signal is SD ³ |
| 6 | INPUT BNC connector | Connects to the SDI source |
| 7 | ONLED | Lights when receiving power |

³ Standard Definition (SD) means an NTSC or PAL compatible video format, consisting of 480 (for NTSC) or 576 (for PAL) lines of interlaced video



² High Definition (HD) means a video format, consisting of either 720 active lines of progressive video or 1080 lines of either progressive or interlaced video

5 Connecting the VM-2HD HD/SD - SDI DA




Figure 2: Connecting the VM-2HD HD/SD - SDI DA

To connect the VM-2HD, as the example in Figure 2 illustrates, do the following:

- 1. Connect an HD-SDI/SD-SDI video source (for example, a camera) to the INPUT BNC connector.
- 2. Connect up to¹ two video OUT BNC connectors to the appropriate HD-SDI/SD-SDI video acceptors (for example, displays).
- 3. Connect the 12V DC power adapter to the power socket and connect the adapter to the mains electricity (not shown in Figure 2).
